Renovations to the park will include a spray park that optimizes water conservation, climbing structures, benches and tables, playground activity panels, infant play pens & swings, outdoor fitness equipment and a skateboard park. A unique walking/tricycle path made of ‘honeycomb’ shaped stones will also be a part of the design concept. Construction on the Honey Capital Park is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2014.
