Reporting to the Light Oil Operations Manager, the Facilities Team Lead will work closely with Engineers and Field Operations to safely support and execute facility construction and optimization projects.

### Responsibilities:

- Project management (scope, planning, design, and execution) of facility-related projects including well tie-ins, compressor installations/modifications, operational process troubleshooting, and infrastructure debottlenecking.
- Coordinate project deliverables (schedule, regulatory, cost estimates/tracking, drawings, etc.) with internal and external stakeholders.
- Support the Business Unit with troubleshooting of facility-related issues and management of change process.
- Complete evaluations for facility process modifications and enhancements to improve facility performance. Contribute to HAZOP analyses.
- Coordinate Engineers, Operations group, and other stakeholders to develop project scope document(s) for proposed projects including DBMs, MOCs, Operating Manuals and Procedures, etc.
- Support the assets with project prioritization and appropriate team resource allocations.
- Provide leadership and mentorship for the Team while managing personal projects as a working leader.

- B. Sc. in Engineering with at least 15 years of experience in Western Canadian Oil and Gas experience and a registered professional member in good standing with APEGA.
- A deep understanding of large horsepower compression, ie. 500 – 2500 HP.
