Baytex Energy Corp. is an oil and gas corporation based in Calgary, Alberta. The company is engaged in the acquisition, development and production of crude oil and natural gas in the Western Canadian Sedimentary Basin and in the Eagle Ford in the United States. Approximately 81% of Baytex's production is weighted toward crude oil and natural gas liquids. Baytex's common shares are traded on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol BTE.

Baytex has an excellent opportunity for a full-time contractor as a Fluid Movement Coordinator. This position will be responsible for coordinating fluid movement and optimizing associated netbacks across all Viking Light Oil areas. This role will work with operators across all areas, report to the Production Superintendent, and work closely with the Operations Manager.

Key Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate leadership and accountability of the Baytex safety values and policies with staff and suppliers
- Work closely with operating staff to ensure daily tracking and forecasting of deliveries
- Find ways to maximize netbacks associated with the full life-cycle of fluid movement
- Generate a weekly clean oil report, and review invoices
- Monthly check-ins with service providers
- Monthly field tanks inventory updates
- Liaise with all Rural Municipalities
- Coordinate additional services during breakup
- This will be an alternating 5 days on, 2 days off / 4 days on, 3 days off schedule

- Minimum five (5) years' of oil field experience
- Ability to communicate and collaborate well with others in a team environment
- Identify problems and develop solutions
- Valid H2S Alive, WHMIS and First Aid Certificates would be an asset
