Baytex is seeking a candidate for the following position in its Calgary, Alberta office. This position would support the Light Oil Business Unit and would report to the Development Manager. The is responsible for monitoring, analyzing, and developing optimal production strategies for the Viking Asset.

Primary responsibilities include:

- **Operations**
 - Work with asset team members (Exploitation, Exploration, Land and Field Operations) to set, monitor and meet production targets while optimizing production and maximizing value within operating budgets.
 - Compile weekly production reports.
 - Review and promote application of new equipment and/or techniques and report results.
 - Assist Operations with day-to-day production issues and troubleshooting.
 - Evaluate economics of workover candidates.
 - Coordinate and participate in regular area & well review meetings with Operations staff
 - Maintain continuous understanding of operating costs and key cost drivers. Identify and drive cost saving initiatives.
 - Work with Field Operations and Facility Engineering to support the corporate MOC process and integrity management programs.
- **Development Support**
 - Complete applications for reduced spacing approvals, waterflood, and general exemption letters.
 - Provide project controls support for the schedule, budget, AFE generation, providing a project review with a metrics summary.
 - Work with operations team, development, and facility engineers to assure infrastructure can adequately manage development volumes.
- **Data Management**
 - Update and manage the production data capture system (Prod Man) consisting of setting up new wells, facilities, and all other pertinent data.
 - Maintain and update Protrend for the LOBU team and assist with validation of analysis.
 - Ensure schematics are uploaded into Prod Man for the facilities team.
 - Liaise with Production Accounting, Financial Accounting, Marketing, Joint Ventures and Commercial Operations as required.
- **ESG & Regulatory**
 - Encourage safety awareness to prevent accidents within operations.
 - Support Gas-In-Solution testing and records management for GHG reporting.
 - Coordinate the annual inactive well inspections – communication to field, prepare tablets, distribute tables and maintain Clear Compliance database.
 - Evaluate Abandonment candidates.
 - Prepare and communicate in-house and to partners annual pressure requirements for AB pools and submit to the AER once complete.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 5+ years of experience in the petroleum industry.
- Professional Engineer (with APEGA) or C.E.T (ASET) member in good standing.
- Strong knowledge of completions, workovers, abandonments and production facilities & pipelines.
- Software experience in GeoScout, ValNav, Wellview, Excel, Powerpoint, Power BI, Qbyte.
- Strong excel skills and database management.
- Experience with data analytics and using Power BI or similar tools would also be an asset.
- The ability to prioritize and manage multiple tasks is required.
- Must be able to work collaboratively in small, fast-paced teams.
- Professional, team player with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to develop and maintain partnerships through active engagement.
- Strong organization and analytical skills.
- Effective oral and written communication skills.
